

Rules

Conduct of members and guests

- Ensure the cleanliness of and respect for the facilities (changing rooms, showers, courts, reservations terminal).
- Adopt the usual dress code for playing tennis, including appropriate tennis shoes (shirts are required, no jeans or other unsuitable clothes, no black soled footwear).
- Animals are forbidden on the courts.
- Exemplary politeness and perfect sportsmanship are required on and off the court.

Reservations and use of the courts

Online reservation system

The Tennis Club of Founex has opted for an online booking system, PLUGIN, to facilitate the reservation of courts and the related administrative tasks. Here are the rules:

- Anyone wishing to become a member of the TCF is obliged to register on the site and pay the financial obligations before using the courts. The rates are to be found <u>here</u>. After validation of the payment, the member will receive his login ID by email within 5 working days. Upon receipt, he will be able to access his bookings, status, etc. at any time.
- 2. Mandatory purchase of the validation card (CHF 10.-) for all new members, valid from March 1st, 2022. The purpose of the card is to validate the reservation on site. If the member wishes, he can activate his reservation through his mobile phone (by always activating the geolocation of the device). The reservation system can also be used via the smartphone application Plugin.ch, available on Android or Apple.
- 3. The reservation of a court can be done in 3 different ways: 1) via the smartphone app Plugin.ch, 2) directly at the terminal (on site) or 3) via the reservations site <u>Plugin</u>.
- 4. All courts can be reserved remotely either through the online reservation system at the address: https://plugin.tcfounex.ch/reserver.php, or via the Plugin.ch app for smartphone or at the terminal situated at the club.
- 5. The reservation of a court must contain the name of the other player(s) of the game. Any abuse by impersonating another member will be sanctioned. The reservation of a court with 3 players is considered as a single.
- 6. Any reservations of a court must be validated by all the players registered in the reservation (via the terminal's reader or by geolocation on a smartphone) 30 minutes before and up to 10 minutes after the start of the scheduled game. After this time, the court will be considered vacant and the available place may be occupied by other players.



- 7. The Committee is automatically notified of any game cancelled (following the non-presentation of a sufficient number of players, non-validation at the terminal or via geolocation). Penalties will be incurred from the tenth reservation that was not cancelled in advance, 30 minutes before the start of the game.
- 8. You can now have two open reservations to use freely within eight days.
- 9. The game of singles lasts 60 minutes (1 hour) and the game of doubles (consisting of 4 players "members") lasts 90 minutes (1 hour 30 minutes), including the sweeping of the court (courts 4, 5 and 6).
- 10. The members can access the status of the reservations of the 6 courts at any time but only the Committee will be able to access the photos of the members, and names and first names of the persons having made a reservation.
- 11. Registration for group lessons, for various courses will be made through the reservation system.
- 12. The Committee and the tennis teacher may reserve one or more courts at any time for courses, stages, interclubs training, interclubs, events and tournaments.

Guests and rental

13. Any member wishing to play a game with a guest will reserve their time via the reservation site and purchase a "guest voucher" which they will validate at the time of booking (payment by credit card). A member can buy several "guest tickets" in the form of credits and use them at his convenience. See explanatory video here

Adult guest voucher: CHF 15.-

Child guest voucher (up to 15 years old): CHF 5.-

In the event of a member resigning, the purchase of unused guest vouchers will be refunded within 60 days.

Children

14. Unless playing with an adult, children up to the age of 15 are not allowed to play after 18:00 from Monday to Friday, nor on Saturdays and Sundays between 9:00 and 12:00, except if a court is free; at the request of adult members, they must immediately yield the court.

Others

- 15. Membership fees, charges for group lessons or stages will not be reimbursed (including pro-rata) in the event of a move, accident, injury or illness, even on presentation of a medical certificate.
- 16. The daily opening hours for the tennis are those indicated on the noticeboard, from 7:30 to 22:00. During the summer season, the lights are automatically turned off at 22:00.
- 17. Members of the Committee have the right to prohibit access to the courts if they consider them impracticable.



- 18. The Club declines all responsibility in case of accidents, damages or theft inside the Club.
- 19. The Committee reserves the right to modify the current rules during the season for imperative reasons.
- 20. In accordance with the Statutes of our Club, any violation of these Rules, as decided by the Committee may result in the cancellation of the membership.
